Religions, History and Society in Europe and Asia

for the academic years 2010-2012

The “Mircea Eliade” post-doctoral fellowships target researchers whose PhD degree in the history of religions or in a related field (anthropology, ethnology, sociology, Asian studies *et al.*) was awarded in 1999 or later, either in Romania or abroad.

The application file must contain the following items (please see the “Application file” tab).

Depending of the complexity of the project, the grants will be awarded for 12 months (of which a three-month research trip to an institution of their choice in one of the EU member states), for 18 months (of which a four-month research trip to an institution of their choice in one of the EU member states), or for 24 months (of which a six-month research trip to an institution of their choice in one of the EU member states). The monthly stipend while in Romania amounts to 4 000 lei (tax free), supplemented by a monthly allowance of EUR 500 (paid in Romanian currency) for the duration of the research stage abroad, in one of the EU member states.

The application file for the competition (items 1 through 8) must be sent by 31 July 2010 (postmarked), both in print (two copies), by regular mail to the Institute for the History of Religions at the Romanian Academy (Institutul de Istorie a Religiilor, Academia Română, Calea 13 Septembrie nr. 13, 050711 București, sector 5), and in electronic format, by e-mail to postdoc61104@acad.ro. The short-listed candidates (whose applications are retained in the first step of the selection procedure) will be invited to an interview, according to a schedule to be communicated at a later date.

The fellowships take effect on 1 October 2010.
