**Copyright:** *Archaeus* asks contributors to assign their copyrights to RAHR / IHR. This ensures that requests from third parties in order to reproduce their articles are handled efficiently and consistently. RAHR has the right to publish a part of the volumes online. The authors may republish their own material in other publications provided that the journal is acknowledged as the original place of publication.

**Availability worldwide:** Previous volumes, either print or online, are available in **more than 200 libraries worldwide**, including the majority of institutes and faculties, national associations and similar periodicals?? libraries in Europe.

**Exchange | Books for reviews | Library:** the maximum amount of **periodicals** received by a constant **exchange scheme** was **150**, most of them located in Europe and North America, including the best journals in the field. Furthermore, *Archaeus* and RAHR obtained substantial donation of books as for instance from **Abteilung für Religionswissenschaft** (Universität Tübingen), **Dipartimento di Studi storico-religiosi**, Università «La Sapienza», Roma; **École Normale Supérieure** (Paris), **École Pratique des Hautes Études**,

Section des Sciences religieuses, Paris. To them one may add the private donations of essential academic publications from European and Asian countries.
